

Old English Records with the name Vawter.

From Arleigh Kerr: <http://www.users.qwest.net/~arleighkerr/vawter.htm>. A posting by Ronald Couch on 12-13-03 (Genforum) asking if anyone had a friend or relation in Devon who had some time on their hands to do some research inspired me to dig through my notebook. Back in '77, I spent a week wandering through libraries and record offices in Devon and Cornwall taking notes on anything I could find relating to the Vawters.

First though, an opinion based upon an observation. I personally doubt Bartholomew Vawter was born in Devon because the English at the time weren't terribly inventive/flexible/creative when it came to naming their children. Not once in all the records I saw, Vawter as well as non-Vawter, did I see the name Bartholomew given to someone from Devon.

And so, here's what I have:

Page 32:

"Letter (1381) dated 27 November, Richard II confirming a charter granted by Reginald de Valle Torte to his free burgesses of Ess [Saltash]." Witnesses included Phele de Valle Torte, Rogero de Valletorta, Johele de Valletorta clerio.

Page 35-6:

John de Vautort de Clyst and John de Vautort de Modeton are also seignors of the third part of the town of Sutton.

Page 158:

"1637-8

Itm for a prsent given Mr. Risdon to pcure out of his hands such writings as concerned Vauters Fee lately bought by the Towne of Mr. John Hawkyns, and a man and two horses two journeyes to fetch said writings."

Our Early Emigrant Ancestors The Original Lists of Persons of Quality 1600-1700 by John Camden Hotten. Baltimore, Genealogy Publishing Co., 1962, p. 317-320:

Lists prisoners "tainted with high treason" [for taking part in the Monmouth Rebellion] from the Dorchester Gaol being transported to Barbadoes. They were put aboard the Betty of London at Weymouth in Dorset. A certification dated January 18, 1685, witnessed by the officers of the ship on her arrival in Barbadoes that Robert Vawter had died on December 25, 1685 and was "thrown overboard out of the said Ship."

Thomas Vawter is listed at a general assembly at the "Guyhalde" on February 13, 1600.

By the 14th century, the manor of Sutton had been aliented by the Crown and divided into three separate manors. These had been created by the Valletort family to whom Henry II had given the manor and were

called Sutton Valletort, Sutton Ralf and Sutton Prior.

From the West Devon Record Office (1/8):

“Nicolas Hele of Plymouth, Esq. by deed dated 20 February 1649/50 leased to Robert Gloyne of Plymouth, butcher, for 99 years of three lives, a close called Eascots Close, 3½ acres in Plymouth, at High Vauters, adjoining lands of the lessor on west and south, lands of Sir John Hele, Knight, on the North, and close called Lime Pits, adjoining Horspoole Lane on the east.”

p. 111 – Arms of Gilbert Family; quartering includes “Valletort vulgo Vaulter gules, three bend argent, on a bordure sable ten plates.” William Gilbert married Elizabeth, daughter and coheir of Oliver Champernon, Esq. and Egeline his wife, daughter and coheir of Hugh Valletort.

Somersetshire Archeaological and Natural History Society, Volume XVI, 1891 Taunton. “The Barony of Beauchamp of Somerset” by John Balten [maybe Batten].

p. 23 – daughter of Robert II Beauchamp (died about 1196) married Simon de Valletort; their son took the Beauchamp name: Robert III Beauchamp. There was an alliance between the Valletorts and Beauchamps. Hugh de Valletort held 7 knights fees of Robert II. Hugh’s son, Simon de Valletort held the Beauchamp manor of Babcary [sp?] as part of them.

p. 25 – From 9 Henry III to 14 Henry III there was a dispute between the Beauchamps and Valletorts over land, it went to a judge and jury; but the King intervened. Parties decided on waging a battle. Robert Beauchamp hired “Duncan the Scot” a professional combatant, but he died before the day of the battle. Beauchamp then got William de Champerays [sp?] – who won. In 15 Henry III, Henry proclaimed Beauchamp had won, Valletort gave up all right to land and received 200 marks. Barony of Beauchamp descended to Sir John Seymour, father of Jane Seymour (wife of Henry VIII).

[Purely as an aside: If one recalls the Kevin Costner movie “Robin Hood: Prince of Thieves” when the witch advises the Sheriff of Nottingham that since no man will help him, he should seek help from the “animals from the North.” Puzzled for a moment, the Sheriff suddenly breaks into a smile, and says, “Ahhh, the Scots.” Perhaps there was some truth to this, at least from the English perspective. No complaints please, I’m also part Scottish.]
